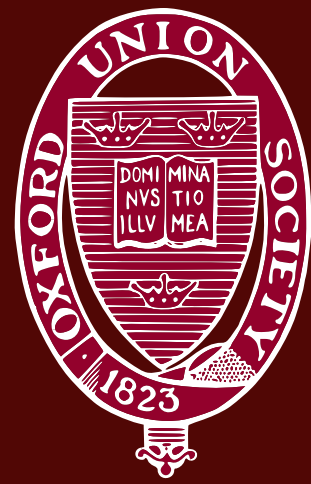

Electoral Malpractice includes (but is not limited to) the following:

Making false or misleading claims intended to influence the election · Bribery · Intimidation Distributing physical campaign material · Making slanderous or libellous statements about a candidate
Campaigning using any University email system Creating websites or promotional videos · Claiming to represent or be supported by any political, racial or religious group · Candidates marking manifesto booklets · Hindering the Returning Officer or their deputies · Unauthorised access or attempted access to another's personal electronic files · Impersonating any other voter when registering to vote · Conspiring to commit, aid or abet malpractice
